2024 Minimum Wages per Sector

The Deputy Minister of Labour, Rolinho Farnela, announced the new wages at a press briefing after the weekly meeting of the Council of Ministers (Cabinet).

- There is no longer a single national minimum wage. Instead, the minimum wage is negotiated by sector and sub-sector. There are now **18 separate minimum wages**.
- These wage rises are all backdated to 1 April 2024.
